

Bambini Nel Deserto (Children in the Desert) is a humanitarian organization created following a trip to Morocco. Since 2000 it has implemented direct and concrete projects and programs. In 19 years over 500 projects have been carried out in 12 countries in all areas of International Cooperation in the field of water, food and food autonomy, health, education and childhood, economic development, migration and the environment.

BnD also operates in contexts of humanitarian emergencies, such as the fight against malnutrition, support for refugees and the protection of minors.

Concretely ... what do we do?

We assure communities have a water supply and fight against desertification, building wells, installing photovoltaic systems to supply pumps, designing and building large-scale hydraulic engineering works such as aqueducts, khetting in Morocco in Hassi Labiad, canalization and reforestation programs in 4 countries.

- We support Food Autonomy, promoting community crops and micro-farming by applying the most modern and effective techniques to traditional techniques such as in the village of Begaa east, Merzouga.

- We build schools and places of reception for minors, we introduce innovative teaching methodologies in national education programs, we organize targeted recovery courses

- We build equipped infirmaries and dispensaries, we deliver ambulances such as Merzouga and sanitary materials to Alnif and Er Rachidia, we organize shipments of medical personnel to Hassi Labiad and El Ramlia, community awareness activities

- We support and promote economic independence by financing the creation of Cooperatives capable of developing Income Generating Activities thanks to microcredit.

We have developed strategies such as the Exodus Program, an ambitious and innovative, unique, intervention plan - in which we have monitored the migratory flows from sub-Saharan Africa to Europe.

Furthermore, by investing in professional training to discourage people from fleeing, we have contributed to reducing the loss of human lives, cooperating in providing professional skills and developing training, convinced as we are that this is the only way to truly sustainable development.

Since 2015 we have activated social inclusion projects in Italy (Tuscany) through training and starting work for foreigners and Italians in socio-economic difficulties.
